Intracytoplasmic Sperm Injection (ICSI) & Oocyte Transfer (OPU)

In 2014, in partnership with University of Liverpool and Niamh Lewis MRCVS, we successfully scanned two of our recipient mares, Pride, in foal from Oocyte Transfer (OPU), and Victoria, from Intracytoplasmic Sperm Injection (ICSI). 2015 saw the arrival of these two foals as we welcomed two healthy colts onto our yard; *Twemlows Galaxy and Twemlows Little ICSI*.

Pictured right with the team, the two are the first of many foals we hope to breed using these advanced reproductive techniques and a further foal is due in 2016. We are now offering these services on a limited basis to suitable mares this season.

Richard Matson, senior partner of Twemlows Stud Farm, sadly passed away on Friday 11th December after a short illness. He farmed at Twemlows Hall and was well known in the 70's and 80's as a producer of hunters and sport horses. Following changes in the farming world in the 1990s he diversified and set up Twemlows Stud which has become one of Europe's leading equine reproduction centres. He was instrumental in the decision to research and develop the latest ICSI and OPU technology (see above), and always took a keen interest in every aspect of the stud. He had a wealth of knowledge and

experience and was always on hand to offer advice to staff and mare owners alike.

Richard was the recipient of the SEIB Meritoire award presented at the British Breeders dinner in London in January. The award was presented in recognition of a lifelong achievement in British breeding.
