Live Question & Answer session

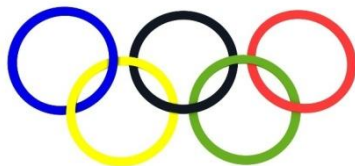
The aim is that people can view the lectures from the comfort of their own home; all you require is a computer, broadband connection and speakers or headphones.
